The Tippecanoe School Corporation is upgrading several network switches. Additionally, the TSC is seeking to clean up and repair cabling in MDFs and IDFs district-wide, as to increase the efficiency of eligible components and to improve connectivity within the school buildings.

The scope of this project is presented in two sections: Switch Needs and Optimization of Cabling. Vendors may bid on both sections or on individual sections. The proposed part numbers, quantities and other particulars for each section are listed in the attached RFP.

Please address Technical questions to the Technical Contact. We will consider multi-year contracts with or without voluntary extensions. All cost proposals must reflect any available governmental unit discounts. Proposal shall provide a separate section listing for each building with all costs associated with the proposal for that building.

Each line item on proposal should clearly list Quantity, Manufacturer, Part Number, Description, Unit Price, and Extended Price.

Proposals MUST separate eligible and ineligible services by line item for all services to which service provider responds.

Vendors may submit alternative equipment as long as the equipment is an equivalent make and model or serves a similar functionality. The Tippecanoe School Corporation reserves the right to adjust quantities prior to purchasing to meet the needs of the corporation.

The award of the Contract will be made to the responsive Bidder whose bid conforms and that is most advantageous to the Corporation, price and other factors being considered. The Corporation reserves the right to reject any and all bids or part thereof and waive any irregularities.
