The East Maine School District 63 is seeking proposals for the provision of equipment, licenses, and parts warranty of a Centralized Access Point Management System (Cloud-Based), Wireless Access Points, Licenses and Related Components for its nine school sites as per RFP specifications. Please note that two of the nine sites are not eligible for E-rate funding and requested equipment must be listed separately. Implementation, including project management, design, configuration, and physical installation of all solutions will be the vendors responsibility. All materials needed or required will be the responsibility of the selected contractor.

The service provider must give the applicant the choice to pay the discounted price or to pay the full price and then receive reimbursement through the FCC Form 472 BEAR process.

Proposals are due on Monday, February 7, 2022 by 12:00 noon CST.

All responses must include detailed pricing for the equipment being requested including, quantity, description of item, manufacturer, model number, part number/SKU, unit price, extended price.
