Questions and Answers

- 1) The city is requesting services POE/Terminating and at 875 Broad street. Service Providers that have current Point of Entry into 900 Lafayette Beacon Hall Housatonic, would this be acceptable with the City?
- 2) Would the city accept a Dim Lit solution? Whereas the service provider provides the customer the required terminating SFP/QSFP instead of the service provider physically installing their NID's.
- 3) For clarification, 875 Broad St. building: Beacon Hall Building 3 is on the corner of Broad and North Frontage. Is this correct?
- 4) If the July implementation date is not met, can Bridgeport School District remain Month to Month with incumbent provider until services are delivered? If so, will the new provider be responsible for the incumbent's month to month charges?
- 5) Is Bridgeport willing to provide contract expiration dates if a non incumbent provider were to be awarded the bid?

Answer:

- 1) This is addressed as Bridgeport Board of Education, not affiliated with the City of Bridgeport. Yes, this would be acceptable, but it would need to enter the campus within Lafayette Hall and would require the permission of the State of Connecticut University System.
- 2) This is addressed as Bridgeport Board of Education, not affiliated with the City of Bridgeport. Yes, this would be acceptable.
- 3) *The legacy "FiberTech" fiber POP is located in Lafayette Hall (Housatonic Campus), we currently have multimode that goes from Lafayette to Beacon Hall right now. If the*

connection can be installed in Beacon to keep it in the same location as where the MDF building is located that would be preferable.

- 4) Yes, this would be acceptable.
