Grandview Heights Schools seeks proposals for a routing and network edge firewall solution to support a 2x2Gbps fiber Dedicated Internet Access (DIA) infrastructure across two (2) primary aggregation sites (campuses) linked at present by leased 10Gbps fiber. The district understands that there are many ways to accomplish their goals, and is open to designs that deviate from the sample provided below as long as they achieve the desired feature set, performance requirements, cost objective, and service life specified throughout this document. The sample specifications provided in the RFP should be considered a best-effort like-for-like lifecycle replacement using the current design.

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Please reference Form 470 #260016030 on all correspondence. This is a request for routers and firewalls, and all accompanying software, licenses, cables, connectors, mounting hardware and any other related items. USAC has advised applicants to include all three types of service on each Category 2 Form 470.  
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YOU MUST REFER TO THE ASSOCIATED RFP Document in EPC for complete details. This is not a formal "RFP," but provides details which should allow service providers to prepare more directed bids. It is important that service providers read the attached document to fully understand this project and prepare a more directed bid. Service Providers are responsible for monitoring the USAC EPC site for any updates to this posting.
