Open or unsupported cabling will not be permitted. The vendor shall test and certify each cable run using industry-standard certification equipment and provide electronic test results upon project completion. Installation must support the transport of broadband within the facility and meet E-Rate Category Two eligibility requirements for Internal Connections.

No splicing will be allowed. Provide proper cable management, strain relief, and service loops where appropriate. Vendor is responsible for cleanup and removal of installation debris.

All materials must be new, manufacturer-certified, and compliant with current structured cabling standards. The service provider must comply with all USAC/E-Rate rules and maintain project documentation consistent with the programs document retention requirements.
