The Pickerington Local School District is requesting proposals for the supply, replacement, and associated removal/disposal of rack-mounted uninterruptible power supply (UPS) units and non-metered rack power distribution units (PDUs) supporting network infrastructure within both Main Distribution Frame (MDF) and Intermediate Distribution Frame (IDF) environments. Applicant is seeking bids for:

1.(2)Vertiv or equivalent 1100VA class rack-mounted UPS units short depth.
 2.(48)Vertiv or equivalent 1500VA class rack-mounted UPS units short depth - qty. 9 and standard depth - qty. 39.
 3.(30)Vertiv or equivalent 2200VA class rack-mounted UPS units standard depth.
 4.(16)Vertiv or equivalent 3000VA class rack-mounted UPS units standard depth.
 5.(84)NON-Metered Rack Power Distribution Units (PDUs) - qty. 68 Vertical rack PDUs and qty. 16 Horizontal rack PDUs. Metered PDUs are not requested and should not be included in proposal.
 6.BMIC - Basic maintenance of Internal Connections for approximately 96 UPS.
 7.MIBS - Managed Internal Broadband Services for approximately 96 UPS.
 The district prefers lithium-ion battery technology due to lifecycle and maintenance advantages; however, equivalent solutions utilizing alternative battery chemistries will be considered provided they meet functional and reliability requirements.
