All switch gear must be 100% compatible with Cisco Identity Services Engine as well as Cisco DNA and must support the Cisco Discovery Protocol, CDP. This equipment must be able to co-exist with the existing equipment and be compatible and/or stackable with existing equipment

The Core Switches must include the advanced IP Routing feature set such as Cisco Network Advantage Option and the ability to provide the necessary 400Gb, 100Gb, and 40Gb size of links to the other devices/sites within the building as well as the connection to the District Data Centers.
