Fort Vancouver Regional Library is seeking proposals for a fully managed, leased lit fiber Ethernet Internet access service or equivalent to a new library facility currently under construction at 222 Durgan St, Washougal, WA 98671. Service will replace the existing Internet connection at the current Washougal Library location and will support the transition to the new facility. The selected service provider may be required to perform all necessary engineering, permitting, construction, and installation activities, including any outside plant or infrastructure required to deliver service to the new location. Due to the construction schedule, respondents should identify any lead times or construction requirements necessary to meet the anticipated service start date. The requested service shall include: Symmetrical Ethernet Internet access over leased lit fiber. Managed service with all required provider-owned electronics. Installation, testing, and turn-up. All monthly recurring and applicable non-recurring charges. Compliance with all FCC E-Rate program rules and requirements. The applicant reserves the right to negotiate service activation dates to accommodate construction schedules and temporary overlap with the existing library location during the transition period.

Restrictions and Procedures

- Be able to process reimbursement via the Service Provider Invoice (SPI Form 474) method and agree to accept only the E-Rate discounted share plus any ineligible costs, unless otherwise specified by the applicant.
- Provide all required E-Rate documentation (including but not limited to Program Integrity Assurance [PIA] responses) upon request.
- Provide an annual breakdown of eligible costs for services and/or equipment to support BEAR (Form 472) submissions, if applicable.
- Offer Lowest Corresponding Price (LCP) as defined in the FCCs Fourth Report & Order (FCC-97-420).
