Summary of the HCP's requested services. :

Medical Grade Networks and Medical Clouds are mission-critical environments designed to be resilient, highly available, and hardened. Their purpose is to provide secure transport and connectivity among eligible Healthcare Providers (HCPs), partners, and information resources (including Electronic Health Records and other clinical or operational content)

necessary to support the delivery of healthcare services within the communities served. Respondents shall propose an Internet Service (a commodity best effort Internet Service is acceptable). All functionally equivalent options will be considered. At minimum, vendors are requested to provide pricing for the following transport speeds: 1 Mbps, 8 Mbps, 20 Mbps, 25 Mbps, 40 Mbps, 50 Mbps, 100 Mbps, 150 Mbps, 200 Mbps, 250, 500 Mbps, and 1 Gbps. Any speed within the ranges being sought may be proposed. Pooled Data Plans may be considered. The request for pricing at these specified speeds does not limit upgrades at only those speeds. When an upgrade is required, pricing for bandwidth levels not listed (e.g., 125 Mbps) may be sought so long as the bandwidth level falls within the range requested. The purpose of this request is to obtain standardized pricing to support informed, cost-effective decisions regarding potential broadband upgrades during the contract term. Requests for site and service substitutions shall be allowed in accordance with program rules. This provision allows for site and upgrade or change service options throughout the length of the contract. Please include clearly defined service level agreements (SLAs) with measurable performance metrics and non-performance remedies. No preference is given to any specific carrier, provider, or technology. The "A" location for all proposed services shall be the eligible HCP where the circuit originates (like the Hospital). The "Z" location shall be a Medical Cloud or another location that enables connectivity into the existing network, including another applicant-operated HCP or facility. - On Internet Service: BBAHC is seeking to source a cost-effective Internet Access connections - multiple awards may be issued. Awards may provide a primary service, mobile service, address resiliency, and/or be secondary connections providing backup services. Connections may be used for a dedicated guest network so as remove congestion from the primary network. Best effort and asymmetrical services shall be considered. For the Internet, the speed shall be between 8 and 1000 Mbps. - On Transport Service to the administrative office: BBAHC is seeking the most cost-effective medical grade network services and possible between the Kanakanak Hospital and their administrative location in Anchorage. For Transport, speed should be 100 and 1000 Mbps. - Seeking the most cost-effective medical grade network services and possible options for network resilience between the Kanakanak Hospital and their administrative location in Anchorage. Options for Internet Access associated with Kanakanak Hospital requirements may also be awarded. Existing contracts and or invoices may be utilized as bid responses / proposals.
